


"Putin" is an epic biopic of Vladimir Putin which takes place throughout six decades. The story unfolds in two ways; the metaphysical and the material. In the former sphere, we're witnessing Putin's journey from his childhood in his abusive stepfather's home, situated deep within the Soviet Union, and then following him into crime-ridden Leningrad of the 60s, populated by criminals pardoned after Stalin's demise, among whom Vladimir will grow up.



We're watching the most pivotal events in both his life as well as in world's history; Putin entering KGB ranks, the Chernobyl nuclear meltdown, and the collapse of the USSR - an event which kicks off his political career.

As Putin rises to dictatorial power, we get a peek behind the curtain of pivotal moments in modern history, including the war in Chechnya and the assassination of Dzhokhar Dudayev (which was facilitated by Bill Clinton, who provided Boris Yeltsin with access to the Saturn Satellite phone network used by Dudayev). The film also explores the real reasons behind the Moscow theater massacre, the Beslan school siege, and the bombings of residential buildings in Russiaevents that had a profound impact on the whole world.













PUTIN AND AI

Director's Statement

PUTIN is a film that tells a story unfolding right before our eyes.

My goal was to offer viewers a unique experience, allowing them to get incredibly close to the Russian dictator.



Given this aim, I knew I couldn't simply cast an actor with makeup to resemble Vladimir Putin.

I wanted people, familiar with the dictator to feel as if they were truly interacting with him. Initially, it seemed that using classic deep-fake technology was the way to go. However, the results were disappointing. We collaborated with four studios—two in Los Angeles and two in Europe—all attempting to train an AI model based on high-resolution footage and images of Putin. It turned out to be impossible to achieve a satisfactory effect due to the insufficient quantity of high-resolution material available online.

So, I gathered CGI specialists from my network and proposed that we develop our own technology to overlay Putin's face onto an actor. We worked on this for two years, creating eight different engines.

After a year and a half, the results were better than deep-fake but still not satisfactory to me.

The visuals still had a computer-generated feel, especially in close-up shots, which require a significantly higher level of detail than medium shots. Achieving a realistic close-up on the big screen where an actor's face is the size of a small building would require a completely different technology.

The breakthrough came in the last six months. One morning, I woke up with a crazy idea. I called my special effects supervisor and suggested we abandon our previous approach and try something entirely different. Often, my best ideas come to me early in the morning, and I like to think they are gifts from above. This time, the final engine we created turned out to be the most revolutionary, delivering the best results among all our efforts over the past two years.

When we presented about 45 minutes of footage featuring Putin at the Cannes festival, industry professionals were astounded. They said it looked even better than Marvel's work, as our depiction of Putin didn't have the tell-tale signs of CGI that sometimes mar even the best productions.

I'm incredibly proud that after two years of challenging work, we succeeded in creating a technology that delivers such a high-quality result. The success of our efforts has led us to establish a new company, AIO Technology, aimed at providing these tools to the film industry to support other productions worldwide.

The world depicted in the film has been based on locations from the following countries: Ukraine, Russian Federation, Israel, Poland, Syria and Jordan.

The film offers a powerful platform for us to artistically protest against the Russian dictator and the war in Ukraine.

Following his footsteps, I aim to immerse the saints and demons of my film into the gritty reality of Saint Petersburg's streets. My portrayal will reflect a city full of ragged and disheveled people with tormented Russian souls.


PATRYK VEGA


Director/Writer/Producer

Patryk Vega is the highest-grossing director and producer of films in Europe's fifth largest market. So far, Vega has made 19 feature films and 16 television series. He is also the creator of documentary series and the author of four books. Vega's films have amassed an audience of nearly 40 million viewers, and his TV series productions have an audience of over 100 million. His productions have broken popularity records on platforms: svod, Netflix, Amazon, Showmax, Canal+, HBO.

Patryk Vega has won many prestigious awards for best box-office performance in theaters. He has also received the Polish President Lech Kaczynski Award for Outstanding Film Achievements Abroad, and the Best Director Award at the world's largest crime cinema festival, Noir in Festival, whose winners also included such prominent filmmakers as Quentin Tarantino and Martin Scorsese.

The distribution of Patryk Vega's productions has so far taken place on 5 continents. Patryk Vega's films have been spectacularly successful in Europe.
